 - Homologation (AEFE) Visit from Christine Paufam (May 2018)
 - Visit in next 24 months because we now have a 7th grade to make sure we are compliant
 - Emphasis is on AEFE Projet d'etablissement for direction of school and improvement
 - Action/strategic plan related to cycles and the French Curriculum. (improvement plan for schools with resources)
 - Will have stakeholder input, will be workshops for teachers thru our AEFE network (train the trainer model).
 - A LOT of work for staff, Principles etc. with accreditation and with Homologation and the AEFE Project d'etablissement.
 - Detachment is getting harder to obtain (w/retirement in place). Some regions and academies. Right now AIS has plenty of applicants.
 - Third MLF advisor (and speaks English). Schools pay part (required) \$4/student
 - Workshops/training can cover training like coding project, gamification of learning, other Parcours.(expensive \$200-300 /class as example)
 - Will have to start reporting 'outside' the classroom participation
 - This is official French government process

- ENROLLMENT UPDATE
- Projecting 53 new students, Mathilde is doing a great job and supported by April
- Projection of 187 Total (start with ~180).
- New enrollment is fairly strong (especially since many international schools are having issues w/ maternelle enrollment.
- Attrition is higher than we want (58 is the most conservative i.e. worst case scenario).
- Normal GS attrition, and many from CP families are moving, ~121 students returning
- CM2-Made good from difficult situation. Classes seem to really love the new sub (6th grade) teachers and the teachers are really pulling their weight and dedicated, very dedicated, 6th grade teachers.

- Debt Service fees (HOS got help from Bruno in DC in charge of French schools). We have fees (not written in our finance agreement, but in French Gov Documents). 0.3% of remaining principle. 2011 thru now is \$56k. And it may be legit French expense. (1 Euro/year plus 0.3 on
